

Choosing a Lifejacket or Buoyancy Aid



50 to 100 Newtons Buoyancy.

Buoyancy aids with 50N should be used by persons who are swimmers in sheltered waters, when help is close at hand. They are not guaranteed to turn a person from a face down position in the water. Remember, buoyancy-aids just give you extra flotation.

They will not turn you face up if you are unconscious.



Lifejacket 150 Newtons

The 150N Lifejacket is for those who may have to wait for rescue, but are likely to be in sheltered calm waters. It may not have sufficient buoyancy to protect someone who is unable to help themselves and may not turn an unconscious person on his or her back. Particularly when wearing heavy clothing.



Lifejacket 275 Newtons.

The 275N lifejacket is recommended for those working offshore. For example Sea fishing and commercial users. Intended for use in extreme conditions and when wearing heavy protective clothing that may adversely affect the self righting capacity provided by lifejackets with less buoyancy. It is specially designed to ensure the wearer is floating in the correct safe position, with their mouth and nose clear of the surface.



Lifejacket 275 Newtons. + Integral Harness

The 275N lifejacket is recommended for those working offshore. For example Sea fishing and commercial users. Intended for use in extreme conditions and when wearing heavy protective clothing that may adversely affect the self righting capacity, provided by lifejackets with less buoyancy. It is specially designed to ensure the wearer is floating in the correct safe position, with their mouth and nose clear of the surface. Specially designed for work on sea engineering.
